Corridor Title Cares Grant Awarded to Helping Hand Home for Children

Corridor Title, based in Austin and Dripping Springs, awarded Helping Hand Home for Children a \$25,000 grant on April 25, 2016. HHH was chosen from a group of 17 non-profit nominees to receive this generous grant that will help fund the growth of the Home's foster and adoption program.

Real Estate Company Corridor Title decided to make local philanthropy an essential component of its business model. Company owners, including owner and founder Patrick Rose, came up with the grant program "Corridor Title Cares" to support the charitable passions of other real estate professionals across our community. The winner was picked by a panel of community leaders based on the number of nominations, the personal commitments of the volunteers to the nominated charities, and the degree to which the organization could leverage the \$25,000 prize.

According to Ted Keyser, Executive Director of Helping Hand Home, "The Home is growing to address the needs of the Central Texas community. There is a capacity gap in the number of quality foster homes that can serve foster children, especially high needs children, in Travis County and Central Texas. To meet this important need the Home has launched the Families First Initiative, with the goal of doubling the number of foster homes and doubling the number of children we can serve now and in the future and, most importantly, provide support services for these families so that children can thrive, succeed, and achieve permanency in their new placement. To achieve our goals we need the financial support of community-minded businesses like Corridor Title. Businesses, individuals and foundations in our Central Texas community provide 55% of our funding, and we could not fulfill our mission without their support."
