BUILDING A FUTURE OF HOPE 2020 CAPITAL CAMPAIGN

NEW HOUSING - The project will fund the construction and furnishing of eight on campus homes and overall bed capacity will increase by 41%.

FOREVER HOMES - The Foster and Adoption Program is on its way to doubling in size and will have new office space to grow, train and nurture our growing

community of foster and adoptive parents.

NEW EDUCATION BUILDING -

The new and modernized facility will replace the portables, will add classroom space, and will add a community room for staff and family trainings and meetings.



SUSTAINABILITY FUND - Will support

the increased cost of providing additional housing, education, foster and adoption services for three years after project completion.
